**VII. Summer 2020**


It was decided to not run Rock the Routes in 2020. The focus will be on the fireworks/Independence Day celebration on Saturday, July 11, 2020.

**VIII. OTHER BUSINESS**


A question was asked about selling centennial themed holiday mugs or tree ornaments at the tree lighting.

**IX. ADJOURNMENT**


A motion was made by Kirsten Wall at 8:05 p.m. to adjourn the meeting. Motion was seconded by Regina Petersdorff. All in favor.


